- (c) No person shall be entitled to receive a FPCBP Scholarship for Undergraduate studies more than once;
- (d) An applicant may receive a FPCBP Scholarship as a Graduate student once in each of the three categories specified (i.e. Post Diploma or Degree, Master’s, Doctoral);
